

## Statement on WEEE Directive

EU Directive 2012/19/EU on waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) imposes legal obligations on manufacturers of electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) when placing their products on the European market. Each EU Member State enforces this directive through national legislation, which specifies the unique requirements for WEEE implementation within that particular Member State.

Nexperia manufactures semiconductor components for integration into electrical and electronic equipment (EEE). These components lack independent functionality, serving only within the context of the equipment they are installed in. This aligns with the categories of EEE outlined in Annex III of the Directive, as well as the examples provided in Annex IV. Consequently, Nexperia's semiconductor components are only indirectly impacted by the WEEE Directive, for example by the requirements set out by RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU.

Some Nexperia components use brominated flame retardants in their encapsulating mould compound, a substance relevant to WEEE Directive. Products free of these brominated flame retardants are marked with a 'HALOGEN FREE' logo on their packing labels.

To facilitate compliance checks and inform the public, we make product composition declarations available on our public website. The signature below verifies that the above statements, including any product composition data, are valid and accurate to the best of our knowledge.

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
